The Tehama Campus is Coming, Too!

In Fall 2009, Shasta College's former facility was replaced by the new Tehama Campus, a state-of-the-art facility boasting a centralized Student Services area, high-tech classrooms and computer labs, and its very own science lab (scheduled for completion in Spring 2010) to support the growing needs in environmental, nursing, and forestry science programs. Situated on a portion of the former Diamond Mill adjacent to the Sacramento River, the campus site contains a five-acre pond, oak woodlands, and tremendous views.

Forest Science and Technology Training

Due to a number of factors affecting the forestry industry, a severe shortage of qualified and well trained foresters is expected in the foreseeable future...and Shasta College is responding. Students have the opportunity to receive training and develop skills for a variety of career opportunities in either seasonal or permanent employment. Using the ITV network as well as on-site labs and field studies, students can become a part in the revitalization and management of this natural resource.
